## SESSION ABSTRACT

---

The Department of Defense currently uses a process called Mission Thread Analysis to identify key assets and facilities needed to execute an operational mission. This method, known as Mission Decomposition, has unlimited possibilities for use in identifying the energy needs and supporting infrastructure of electrical loads that support community resilience functions including public safety and other immediate lifesaving and life-sustaining capabilities. This session will provide a guided discussion on the ways in which these planning processes can be applied to meet homeland security and emergency management priorities by identifying interdependencies in infrastructure, aid in the development of energy assurance performance criteria, and help communities achieve mission-driven hazard mitigation from disruptions in electric service.
